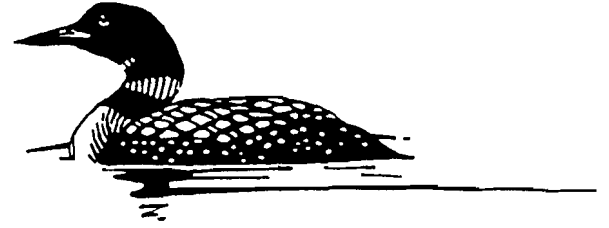

Common Loon Nest Platform

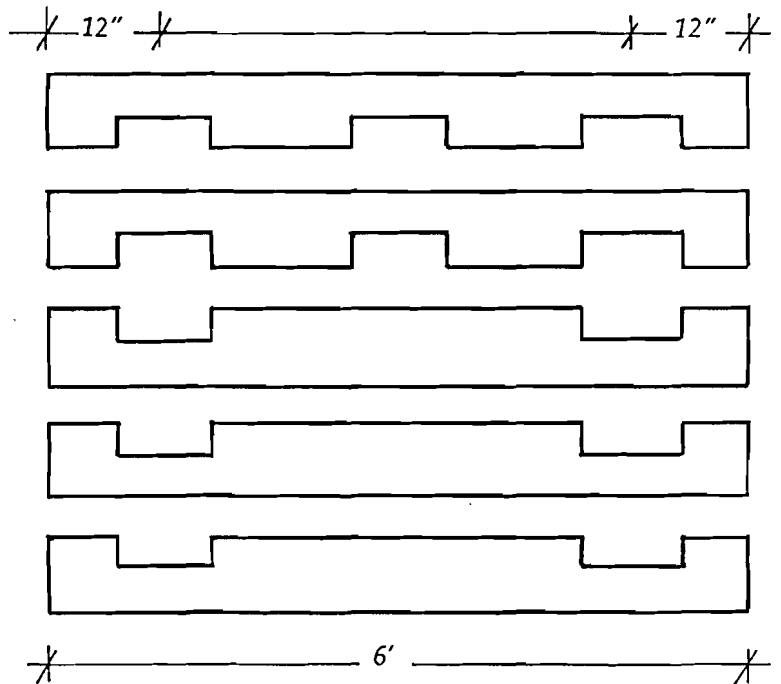
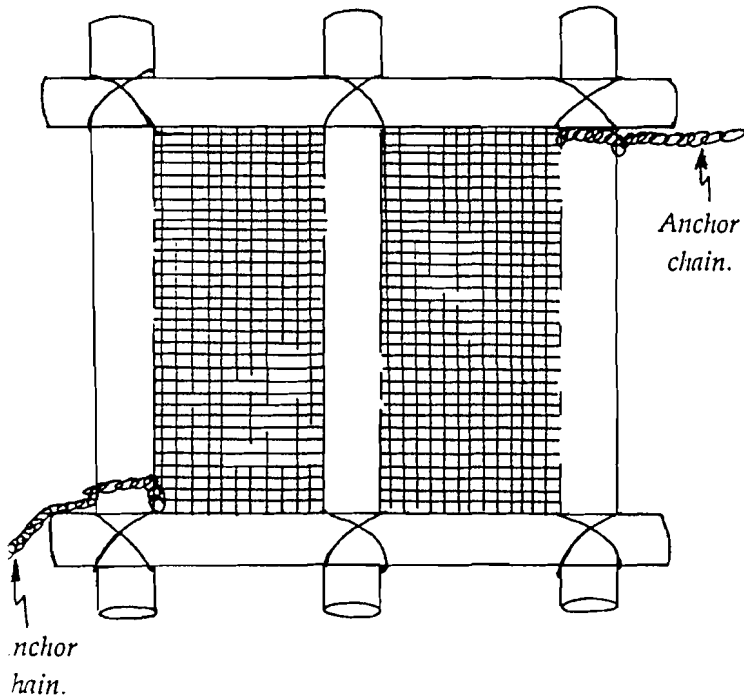

Materials:

Five 10" diameter cedar poles - 6 feet long.
One 4' x 4' welded wire screen (2" x 4" mesh).

*Notch logs and latch together with wire.
Staple wire screen under raft.
Fill raft with wet aquatic vegetation.
Anchor with chains at opposite corners.*
